Lt. Governor Bethany A. Hall-Long was sworn in as Delaware's 26th Lt. Governor on January 17th, 2017.

Bethany pursued her childhood dream of becoming a nurse at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia. She went on to pursue her MSN in community health nursing from the Medical University of South Carolina. Bethany completed her PhD in health policy and nursing administration from George Mason University, and served as a fellow for the U.S. Senate as well as the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Bethany has been a member of the University of Delaware (UD) Nursing Faculty now for nearly twenty years. She was the first nursing faculty at UD to receive the University-wide excellence in teaching award and is currently a Professor of Nursing and Joint Faculty in Urban Affairs. Her research and community service record with at-risk groups such as pregnant teens, diabetics, homeless and the mentally ill, makes her a nationally recognized health scientist.
